



Hon'ble Revenue Minister's Announcement

2012-13

Announcement No.1

With a view to strengthen the Chief Minister's Uzhavar Pathukappu Thittam a provision will be made enabling the dependent members to get all benefits under the Scheme even after death of farmer member in the family. Thus dependent member shall avail educational and marriage assistance.

Present stage

Government in G.O. (Ms.) No.255, Revenue Department, dated 10.7.2012 issued orders in this regard and accordingly in this office letter dated 13.07.2012 instructions have been issued to the District Collectors requesting them to give due publicity and to extend the benefits of education and marriage to the children (dependants) of the deceased members.

Announcement No.2

During the temporary incapacitation of the farmer member on account of T.B, Cancer and other terminal diseases rendering the farmer incapable of doing any work, the affected farmer member shall be provided a monthly pension of **Rs.1000/-** during the ailment till the disease is cured

Present stage

Government in G.O. Ms. No. 285, Revenue [LR1(2)] Department dated 6.8.2012 have ordered to sanction of the monthly pension of **Rs.1,000/-** to the farmer member during the temporary incapacitation of farmer member who is affected on account of TB, Cancer and other terminal diseases. Further, as per the G.O, Executive Instructions have also been issued to all the District Collectors in consultation with the Principal Secretary to Government Health and Family Welfare Department vide this officer letter dated 12.09.2012

As on **15-12-2012**, under this category a sum of **Rs.26.49 lakhs** has been distributed to **2,165** persons.

Announcement No.3

Surplus lands in the following areas shall be distributed to the eligible persons with proper sub-division during the current year.

1. Thanjavur, Nagapattinam and Tiruvarur	=	1017.47 acres
2. Thoothukudi and Tirunelveli	=	1545.29 acres
3. Tiruchirapalli	=	295.00 acres
4. Erode	=	86.00 acres

Total	=	2943.76 acres

Present stage

Government in G.O. Ms. No. 144, Revenue dated 17.5.2012 have issued instructions to the District Collectors to complete the works as per announcement on or before 15.08.2012. The above said works have been completed in all the Districts involving clear cases. In respect of cases involving violation of conditions, court cases, etc., further follow-up action is being taken by the respective JC/ACs (Land Reforms).

Announcement No.1

The Government will focus special attention in the implementation of Land Reforms Act. The lands declared as surplus in Periammapatti village will be distributed to eligible beneficiaries properly. Speedy action will be taken on such cases, if available in other areas.

Present stage

- Survey and Sub-division works in Periyampatti, Dindigul district have been completed by a special team of Surveyors.
- Meanwhile, erstwhile landowner has filed a Writ Petition before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court. The Hon'ble Court has ordered that there shall be an order of interim injunction restraining the respondents from issuing of patta to third parties during the pendency of the revision petition before the DRO, Dindigul. The DRO has disposed of the Revision petition. Counter

Affidavit has been prepared and filed before the Hon'ble Court to vacate stay and dispose the Writ Petitions.

- Further, follow-up action regarding enquiry, inspection, etc., is being taken by the RDO, Palani and the AC (L. Ref.) Madurai without issuing any patta in view of the Hon'ble High Court's order.

Announcement No.2

Speedy action will be taken to dispose the cases relating to temple lands and other lands pending in Revenue Courts.
